Common policy topics in all regions

- ASN policy
- IPv4 Depletion
- IPv6 transfers

Common Policy Topics (1/5)

- Internet Assigned Number Authority (IANA) Policy for Allocation of ASN Blocks to RIRs, ratified by ICANN in September
 - ripe-480 is active in RIPE NCC Service region
 - 32-bit ASN block only from 1 Jan 2011

Common Policy Topics (2/5)

- IPv4 Depletion
 - AfriNIC: Soft Landing Policy, in discussion at Afrinic XIII
 - APNIC: Eligibility for critical infrastructure assignments from the final /8 (prop-085)

Common Policy Topics (3/5)

- IPv4 Depletion
 - ARIN: allocation policy activated by last /8 received from IANA
 - LACNIC: allocation policy activated when the last /12 address pool occurs

Common Policy Topics (4/5)

- IPv6 Transfer
 - AfriNIC: Soft landing Policy, /12 set aside and automatic IPv6 assignment, in discussion at AfriNIC XIII
 - APNIC: Allocation Policy for IPv6 deployment (prop-087)

Common Policy Topics (5/5)

- IPv6
 - ARIN: /10 reserved for immediate IPv6 deployment
 - LACNIC: no single aggregation requirement in the routing of the initial IPv6 allocation

withdrawn after RIPE 60

- 2009-01 “Global Policy for the Allocation of IPv4 blocks to Regional Internet Registries”:
consensus in RIPE community, announced by ICANN as abandoned
- 2010-04 “80% Rule Ambiguity Cleanup”:
consensus

- 2008-07 “Ensuring Efficient Use of Historical IPv4 Resources”: (almost) withdrawn

- 2006-05: PI Assignment Size, end of Review Phase
- 2008-08: Initial Certification Policy for Provider Aggregatable Address Space Holders, end of Review Phase

- 2010-01: Temporary Internet Assignments, editing after Review Phase
- 2010-07: Ambiguity Cleanup on IPv6 Address Space Policy for IXP, Initial Discussion
