Transfer Policy

Mergers, Acquisitions, Takeovers and Closures

- Mergers, acquisitions, take-overs, divestitures,...
- RIPE Document: ripe-301
- Allocations are "moved" between LIRs
- Verified by checking contracts
- Very flexible

Transfer Policy

- Section 5.5 of ripe-498 (IPv4 Policy)
 - cannot have assignments inside the allocation
 - must be evaluated by RIPE NCC
 - -cannot re-allocate within 2 years (!)
- Quite restrictive compared to ripe-301





IPv4 PI vs IPv4 Allocations




IPv4 PI Assignments






... IPv4 vs IPv6 PI






IPv6 LIR Deployment




